2(a) Are the Security Personnel of DAE and its Constituent Units governed by any Specific Rules / Regulations, apart from the various CCS Rules by which most of the Central Government Civilian Employees are governed?	
2(b) If the answer to question 2(a) above is Yes, please provide a copy of that particular set of rules / regulations.	The post of Security Personnel is not available on the roles of BRIT. Hence, no information is available.
2(c) Security Cadre of DAE being the Uniformed Personnel, do any of the rules regulations also officially apply to them i.e. DAE Security, which are specifically meant for the India Armed Forces and / or Paramilitary Forces?	

A norm / tradition has been set in almost every unit of DAE, that all the security personnel of the First Shift (Morning Shift) are required to assemble at a certain place for doing PT / Parade right after ceasing their normal duty of 8 hours. Please provide the following information regarding this:	
3(a) When was this PT / Parade tradition started initially in DAE and its constituent units?	The post of Security Personnel is not available on the roles of BRIT. Hence, no information is available.
3(b) Under which rules, whether CCS or any other, they are forcible required to attend the PT / Parade like a Force Personnel, even after performing their normal duty of 8 hours, and thus forcing them to give their personal time of about 2 to 2.5 hours without any compensation?	
3(c) Please provide a copy of the Documents / Orders / O.M.s by which this PT / Parade has been implemented in DAE and its constituent units.
